Hi Fans,

How are you all? The boys, Stevie, Mac, 'Plonk' and Kenny all send their love and thank you all for the hundreds of letters that they have received; they love reading them all, and they would love to write back to all of you, but the boys just haven't a minute to spare, but keep writing girls. Also 'Plonk' has given me a message to all of you who sent him cards and gifts, he loves them all, and he told me to tell you all that it was the best birthday he has had in a long time.

We are all thrilled that "Sha La La La Lee" got to number 1 in the charts, the boys were really knocked out, it was really a smash hit! Their new record "Hey Girl" b/w "Almost Grown" is also another Smash Hit; it is fantastic, even better than "Sha La La La Lee", so you can imagine how great it really is. The boys' record will be released on the 6th May, so get your copy now, before they are sold out. Also their L.P. is being released on the 6th May. I have heard it, and I know you will all love it. On the L.P. are the tracks ... "Shake", "Come on Children", "You'd better believe it", "It's too Late", "One Night Stand", "Wat'cha Gonna Do About It", "Sorry She's Mine", "Own Up", "You Need Lovin'", "E to D", "Don't Stop What You're Doing", and of course "Sha La La Lee", it really is great, the boys wrote seven of the tracks themselves, Kenny Lynch wrote three of the tracks.

Thousands of you have seen the boys' film "Dateline Diamonds", and the Faces are thrilled that so many of you enjoyed it, a few of you were a bit disappointed, because the boys were not in it enough. The Trade showing of the film was great and they were mobbed at the doors, everyone was pleased to see that so many of you turned up to meet the Small Faces on the 29th March, (Tuesday) they loved seeing you and they would love to meet you again VERY soon. I have had many of you writing to me saying how much you enjoyed yourselves, and that you would love to have another meeting; well that is going to be arranged very soon, and we will try and arrange a meeting for the fans out of London, as well as the fans in London. Stevie, 'Plonk', Mac and Kenny told me that you were the greatest fans ever, and they always welcome new members. There were about one hundred girls at the Trade Showing, they were screaming and crying, Stevie and 'Plonk' were laughing all through the film, because they look a lot different now than when the film was actually taken, but they still looked just as dishy as they do now.

You will all be pleased to know that Kenny has passed his driving test. He was rather nervous, but who wouldn't be? He was so excited when he passed, but we all knew he would as he is such a good driver. He passed on the 4th April.

Stevie, 'Plonk', Mac and Kenny were very pleased to meet the fans who won the Fabulous competition. The girls had tea with the boys and they were very nervous meeting them. Four girls won the competition and they were the envy of thousands. They made the girls very welcome and before long the girls felt very much at ease. Stevie told me later that the girls were very friendly and nice, and then 'Plonk' yelled out from the other office that all the fans were nice. (So that's a compliment for you).

Not very long ago the boys had to have Police following them everywhere they went, because a fourteen year old was reported missing, and the parents of the girl informed the Police that she was mad on the Faces, so the hunt for the missing girl began, and everywhere the Faces went the police were right behind them, but everything turned out right in the end, and the girl was sent home. The Faces were a bit worried about her, so be careful girls, don't do anything foolish. On the 18th April the boys appeared at the Streatham Ice-Rink, and Kenny was badly injured; they were mobbed and Kenny got the worst of it!! Stevie said that there were girls fainting and going hysterical, the poor boys were scared stiff, but when it was all over, they told me that you made them so welcome that they would love to go back there again sometime in the future. When the boys came to the fan-club they were covered in bruises, and aches and pains, but you were all great to give them such a fabulous welcome.

Stevie, Mac, Ken and Plonk'were sent a gorgeous little dog which they named "Poo", (very original). They brought him to the office, and he was a mischievous little dog, we had to keep looking for him, because every time we turned our backs, he had disappeared, and so 'Plonk' got on his hands and knees and started searching for him. Poo was sent to them by a young girl in Oxford, he is really lovely. Also some girls from the North sent the Faces something that they will never forget - 7 alligators!! The boys jumped six feet when they saw them! At first they thought they were stuffed, until they started moving! Kenny was the brave one, he ran first, followed by Mac, then 'Flonk'. Stevie was too scared to move, but as soon as they realised that the alligators were quite harmless, they were not scared. The boys really do love animals - most of you have heard about their visit to the farm, which was in Fabulous. The Faces really enjoyed themselves, they had such fun; it is not often they hav: time to do things like that. They had such fun with the 'pigs', they liked the cows too, and the sheep seemed to be enjoying themselves just as much as the boys were. But girls, <u>please</u> don't send them any more pets, because they are loaded with cats and dogs, etc., and they find it so difficult to look after them all.

You may be interested to know how the fan-clubs are doing. Well, our fan-club is doing absolutely great; we now have over three thousand fans and the membership is growing fast, and we welcome all new members. Some fans have been getting a petition signed for the Faces to appear on the London Palladium Show. They have been getting hundreds upon hundreds of signatures, so fans, why don't you get a petition signed, to any programme that you can think of, and still keep sending in those requests to the Radio Stations. You are all doing a great job.

We now have five fan-clubs in America and Canada, they are doing quite well considering the Faces have never been seen over there, but they have just recorded a show for the U.S.A. television which was taken, on location, at London's Albert Hall, and we hope that will bring more fans in from abroad, but we are very pleased about the amount of fans that the American fan-clubs have got. We now have a fan-club for the North of England; the fan-club's Secretary is called Christine, so for all you fans in the North, don't forget to write to Christine, her address is:-Christine Coupe, 8 Cumberland Ave., Burnley, Lancs. Perhaps Chris can arrange meetings for the Northern fans.

Many of you want to know more about the Faces' brothers and sisters, so I decided to get the boys together and ask them, (almost impossible). The first Small Face I was able to catch was 'Plonk', and in his very 'posh' put-on accent, he told me about his elder brother called Stanley, who is 26 years old, so 'Plonk' is what you might call the 'baby' of the family: before I had a chance to ask 'Plonk' about his brother, he darted off to another interview, so I had to wait a few hours before I could carry on the interview. As Stevie and Mac were not in the office that day, I phoned them and asked them about their family. Stevie told me about his sister Kay, who is thirteen; he gets on very well with his sister and she just loves the group. Mac hasn't any sisters, but he has one brother called Michael, who is 23 years old; he also gets on very well with Mick, they are very much alike. Kenny has no brothers or sisters.

'Plonk' and Mac have recently been to Halifax where they bought lots of fishing gear. They are very keen on fishing and like to go there on the occasional day off. They have both enjoyed fishing since they were about eight years old, and they are still very interested in it.

I hope that you are also able to attend the N.M.E. Poll concert which is being held at Wembley Stadium. I hope to be going, but the tickets are all sold out. Nevertheless I must try and get in; it is on the 1st May. The boys are also on R.S.G. on the 6th May, and afterwards the Wimbledon Palais, and then Saturday Club on 7th May, so send your requests to be played on Saturday Club and other Radio Stations similar to S. Club. It all helps to get the boys to be number one group. The Faces enjoyed themselves when they had to judge a beauty contest, they really had great trouble deciding, but enjoyed every minute of it. Also the boys had a great time at the Bradford Football Match, but as usual they were mobbed. The fans went frantic when their car drew up; there were girls all over the car.

Many of you have been wondering what 'labels' Mac collects. I asked him this only yesterday and he told me that he likes any sort of label, so long as it is very unusual; he even likes matchstick boxes just as long as they have very unusual pictures. He also likes bottles, very tiny ones, that are very unusual and hard to get.

The boys would like to apologise for not appearing at the Ideal Home Exhibition. They realised that many of you were very annoyed and upset, but they really couldn't help it. It was no fault of theirs. They were told that about 700 of you were waiting for them, and when they didn't turn up you were terrifically upset. We are all very sorry about this: I hope you understand that they couldn't help it.

Stevie, Mac, 'Plonk' and Kenny would very much like to thank you for the gifts you have sent them. They have loads of Gonks and they love them all: they get so many gifts and they are always thrilled with them. They receive Gonks, cloths, rugs (with Small Faces put on them), dolls, sweaters, shoes and loads and loads of other things.

The boys are still mad over the check trousers; you can't blame them when they look so good in them, can you? Stevie is so pleased that you loved them when they wore suits and ties. They told me that they will only wear them on special occasions, but don't they look smart? They are always buying suede shoes in Carnaby Street, also Stevie has bought a blue three-quarter length raincoat, because he is always ruining his suits and jackets, so he decided to get something for the rotten weather; it looks really 'Kinky' - it is very shiny. The boys have already had some suits made by a very excellent tailor. It is very different from what they usually wear. They did not buy these suits in Carnaby Street, and they look terrific in them, they look very handsome.

'Plonk' and Kenny, Mac and Stevie have been shopping for their house. They have been buying everything new and the house looks very nice. They bought a new three piece suite and lamp stands and everything you can think of. They had great fun picking out all these items.

I would like to apologise for any delays in dealing with letters and membership cards, but the membership is growing so fast it is impossible to keep everything up to date, but I do try! I am trying to get some badges for the fan-club; it will be quite a time before you can have one, but they will be great when the badges are ready. They will have the Faces' photo on the badge, so what more could you want. (Except the Faces!)

We are contemplating hiring a theatre in London for all of you to meet the Small Faces. There will be coaches available from towns as far as Manchester, the charge will be very small, to cover the coach journey. If you are interested, please enquire, and send a stamped addressed envelope, (as you must realise fan-club finances are low). We will let you know further details as soon as possible.

Well fans, I shall have to say goodbye now, so keep on writing to me and the boys and tell all your friends to write to me for membership. A lot of you are still writing to Fran & Yvonne at 18, The Dell. Well, they resigned months ago, so please write to the address on the first page. The boys hope to see you all very soon.

Dear Fans,

Well I am back again with lots more news about the fab Faces, so much has happened so I had better begin straight away. First of all Stevie, Mac and Plonk and Kenny would like to say 'Hi' to you all, and to thank you for all the letters, cards and gifts that they have received, and I myself would like to thank the fans who have sent me postcards, we hope you are all enjoying your holidays.

I expect you all know by now that the Faces won the contest for the "Battle of the Giants", we only hope that they win the Melody Maker contest for the best group of the year in Britain. You have all done a great job by helping buy the Melody Makers and filling them in, the Small Faces are very proud of you.

Well fans have you all heard the Faces' new single??? isn't it fantastic! It must get to number one, it is too good for words. In case you do not know, the single is called "All or nothing" 'B' side is called "Understanding". Also the boys are working on a new E.P. which won't be released for a few months yet. Lots of you keep asking me about another L.P.: well, here's a shock for you, the Faces will have a new L.P. out by Christmas, so tell your parents and relatives to start saving, so you can be sure of getting your copy.

A couple of months ago I went to Wales with Stevie, Mac, Plonk and Kenny, as you can imagine I had a tremendous time. As soon as we arrived in Wales the boys had to tune-up. After their Road Manager Terry fixed all the gear which was all set on the stage, the boys played for about 30 minutes, and then Plonk, Mac and Kenny went off! So Stevie and myself were left alone. After chatting for about 10 minutes, I mentioned to Stevie that it was very quiet, so he jumped up and said "I think I'll have a go on the drums", so he sat himself down and started banging away I had never seen him play them before and the result was at the drums. fantastic. A few minutes later another drummer appeared, and as there were two sets of drums he joined in, then two guitarists came in and jumped on the stage and started playing, then Miar Davies (who was singing in the same show) started singing and it was a great performance. Kenny came in, and the expression on his little face, he beamed at Stevie and sat next to me looking very proud, and there I was clapping my heart out. If only I had taken my camera, it was a sight that I'd love all you fans to have seen. The show itself was great, the audience was terrific; the Faces did two twenty-five minute performances and each time the hall was packed. The girls and boys were clapping and screaming as loud as they could. I went into their dressing room and met the boys as they were coming off the stage, and they were soaked to their skins from all the dancing around they did on stage. It was then time I left, so I said "Cheerio" to them all and Stevie hugged me goodbye because they were leaving that night for their Scottish tour.

Many of you would like to know what the Faces think of their fans, I asked them and this was the result:- Stevie thinks fans are marvellous, he loves chatting to you. Before he appears on each show he gets a little nervous, but as soon as the screaming starts he immediately feels relaxed as he knows he has a good audience. I then asked Plonk, and he told me that he just loves the fans, but gets extremely frightened when he sees them running towards him, that is when he decides to 'bolt', so girls and boys if you decide that you want Plonk's autograph, don't run after him, or he will run faster!!! Kenny also thinks that fans are very important to him, and he admires them when he sees the same fans at each performance they play at. He prefers to hear about yourselves when he is talking to you than to talk about himself. Mac always talks about his fans and how great they are, he loves waving at you from the fan-club window, as he often does, and he always finds time to chat to you.

I get lots of letters asking me what I personally think of the Faces, STEVIE: is extremely friendly and chats to everyone as well here goes. though he has known them for years, he is always happy and I have never yet seen him in a mood, he is very well mannered and has a nice personality. When fans tear him apart he gets very angry (as a lot of you already know) but he forgets all about it after a few minutes, when he has forgotten Stevie is also very interested in what happens in the about his bruises. fan-club, and reads all his letters and helps in any way he can. PLONK: is also a very friendly person and very friendly towards the fans, he is a very happy person but he gets easily upset and has a temper, but like Stevie he soon gets over it and is back to his normal happy self. Plonk is more business-like than the other three and likes to know exactly what's what. When he reads his mail he puts on that posh accent and reads them aloud, if they have "personal" on the letters he disappears into another room, and comes out blushing, and will never show me them. KENNY: is supposed to be the quiet Small Face but only occasionally does he get his quiet moods. He is always up to mischief and jokes around all day, the only thing that ever upsets Kenny is - traffic wardens - then you will see him at his worst (when he gets a parking ticket). He is very sweet; when I fin when I first started working for them he seemed very shy, but he certainly isn't now. MAC: is always prancing about the fan-olub offices, one minute he's in the office and then next minute he has disappeared. He takes everything as it comes and never complains about anything, he is very likeable and chats away all the time. He has just been given a huge cigar, but he told me after a few puffs he begins to choke, but he loves them (when he's not choking). I love working (slaving) for them because they are great boys, as you will all agree.

On the 29th May I went to see the Faces at the Marquee. I went with Stella who works the switchboard for the boys' Manager. We arrived at 7.20 p.m. to find queues of fans waiting outside, we went in and sat at the front. I met lots of you there and it was nice talking to you all. The Marquee was really packed. As soon as the Small Faces came on the girls went crazy whilst the boys (fans) just grinned. The Faces wore striped shirts which looked fab. They sang tracks from their L.P. and Plonk sang 'Shake'. I could only just about hear him as there was so much screaming. Mac was great on the organ and Kenny was doing a great drumming act, and of course Stevie was terrific. Just before the show finished Stella and I had to leave because the Faces' Road Manager was giving us a lift home. We turned to go and saw lots of legs; girls were on other girls' shoulders and all we could do was push. When I got through I looked round and saw lots of bodies falling all over the place. I must apologise if I hurt anyone (I am very sorry). Stevie told me later that they were well and truly mobbed. Luckily none of them was hurt badly.

The Faces have recently come back from Paris; the French fans went wild. Plonk and Kenny came back with lovely tans. As soon as they returned, they had to fly to Germany, which was a great success. They went for a week and enjoyed themselves very much.

The fan-club is doing very well, we now have over four thousand members plus six fan-clubs in America, and we have seven fan-clubs scattered all over the world. I would very much like to thank Hilary Tonks and her friend Jean Miller who have helped me a lot. Between them they have got me about 30 members and are still working hard, this pleases me very much. Also, Pauline Goatley has been helping out. Pauline and her three friends got a petition signed with over three thousand signatures for the boys to appear on 'Blackpool Night Out'. It is marvellous the way you are all helping me.

Stevie, Mac, Kenny and Plonk went to Hyde Park, horseriding, and they were all very good. Kenny and Stevie go horseriding a lot and are almost experts, but for Mac and Plonk it was practically their first time on a horse. A bit of bad luck struck Stevie because the horse he was on was rather wild and decided he did not like him sitting on his back, so he did the original thing, he tossed him off!!!!! Much to Stevie's disapproval, and he nearly broke his back. Plonk thought it was very funny sitting on a horse and just laughed and laughed till he nearly fell off! and Mac started trotting with the horse but the horse did not want to trot, he wanted to gallop, so off he went with Mac holding on for his life!! Fut really they enjoyed themselves, although I do not think that Mac and Plonk will go again for some time.

The fan-club badges will soon be ready, they take a long time to make, so fans just be patient. The badges will cost 9d. and you MUST send a stamped addressed envelope or you will not get your badge. They will be great when they are ready, with a fab photograph on the front.

I have been taking lots of photographs of the Small Faces, and they have come out very good. I will be selling them as soon as they get run off on my photo machine. I will be taking lots more when I go to the Faces' flat. I will then take some extremely funny and unusual ones.

If any of you fans have had unusual experience meeting the Faces, (printable ones only please), I will then print them in the next newsletter, which is next October or the beginning of November. I don't mind you sending the unprintable ones, I'll love reading them, but the Small Faces would not allow me to print them.

By the way fans, the Small Faces are raving over the Liverpool group : called "The Clayton Squares". Mac has just bought their latest single called "There She Is", it's great, and the boys never stop yapping about them.

Last Thursday I went with the Faces to Radio England's party which was being held at the Hilton Hotel. I had to meet the boys at their flat. I had to wait for about 1 hour till they were ready, so I played some of their fantastic L.P.'s - they have hundreds - then the car arrived and off we went. We arrived at 8 p.m. The Faces had some photos taken and then we went in to the hall where the party was. Everyone was there including Spencer Davies, Tom Jones, Moody Blues, Ringo, Sandie Shaw, Paul & Barry Ryan, Unit 4 plus Two, Sounds Incorporated, The Truth and much to my amusement Benny Hill and loads of other stars. We sat at our table while the group Zoot Money played, the boys were thoroughly enjoying themselves, Kenny was darting all over the hall meeting all his friends and dancing all the time, Stevie was also chatting away to 'his' friends. He left the party at about midnight as he was very tired, but Kenny was still going in full swing, whoever said that he was the quiet one of the Small Faces??? At about 3.30 in the morning the party was still in full swing, but it was time myself and Lynda (Faces Manager's secretary) were going home. So Kenny gave us a lift. I will never know how we got home, because none of us knew where we were going. All we knew is that we wanted to get to Surrey, so Lynda gave us all the directions, and we somehow got to Surrey in 15 minutes, when it usually takes 30 minutes. Kenny, Lynda and I just cannot work that out!! We arrived at Lynda's house and Kenny stopped the car. Then all of a sudden he fell asleep over the steering wheel, so we had to fill him up with black coffee to wake him up a It was a great evening, one which I shall never forget. little.

Well fans that just about winds it up for now, so keep on sending me your letters, as I love to hear from you. Don't forget about sending me your 'unusual experiences meeting the Faces' - if you have any! And do not forget to send your 9d. and stamped addressed envelope for your badge. Keep on sending your letters to the boys, they have great fun reading them.
